The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Personal identifiers, contacts and characteristics (for example, name, and contact details e.g. phone number, email address, home address)

How we get the personal information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you to communicate details of events run by UKHCA, donation campaigns and requests for volunteers.

We use the information that you have given us in order to communicate details of events run by UKHCA, donation campaigns and requests for volunteers.

We may share this information with Charities Commission to meet reporting requirements and with HMRC when claiming Gift Aid for donations received based on your consent.

Under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are your consent. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting ukhca.info@gmail.com

How we store your personal information

Your information is securely stored.

We keep personal information in our database for indefinite period unless you request us to delete your information. We will then dispose your information by deleting your personal details from our database.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
